Executive Summary

Creating the Workplace of the Future

Like most businesses Ricoh adapted their offices to support hybrid work in the post-pandemic era. They also recognised that the traditional role of the office had changed from being a place to 'do work' to a place where people come to collaborate and innovate.

The challenge was to create an office with the right spaces to support the change. After consulting with employees to understand their needs and their workstyles, the decision was made to build a "Destination Workplace" from the ground up.





The Challenges

Building spaces for sustainability and collaboration

Keeping teams connected

With a distributed workforce across multiple branches, remote locations, and onsite with customers, it was challenging to provide effective collaboration and communication. Modern workplaces need to have a central hub capable of delivering communication equity across locations.

The changing role of the office

With hybrid working, the requirements for office spaces changed. Maximum occupancy was reduced, so desk space was often underutilised. When people came to the office however, they spent more time with their peers, so meeting spaces were over-booked. This affected other spaces such as parking, which were underutilised. Occupancy and office usage data revealed challenges in adapting the space to meet current needs. This led Ricoh NZ to reassess their workplace needs and usage to maximise efficiency.



Key Challenges

- Matching the capabilities of the workplace to the needs of hybrid workers.
- Lack of a flexible office space hindered hybrid work.
- Maintaining productivity and collaboration in a distributed workforce.

The Solution

Envisioning the workplace of the future

Ricoh NZ collaborated closely with their employees to create a transformative “Destination Workplace”. They gathered and assessed staff ideas and feedback through an internal platform. Ricoh technology experts then brought these ideas to life through a design and build process focused on serving the users. The outcome, powered by RICOH Spaces, materialised into a conducive, efficient, and productive environment for both on-site and remote employees.

The new office, located at 34 Sale Street, boasted impressive features. It featured a first-of-its-kind curved video wall for town-hall meetings, a unified online platform for desk, car park, and meeting bookings that promoted employee-led collaboration, a visitor management system, and versatile spaces designed for efficient communication.

The RICOH Spaces platform powers the solutions and provides real-time insights of building occupancy, desk utilisation, meeting room bookings, and more. This turns the office from a static environment to one that can adapt to the needs of the employees and the business as things change.

Ricoh NZ also implemented an advanced building health monitoring system to monitor and adjust air quality for a more comfortable and healthier workspace.

The Outcomes

Strengthening collaboration, improving productivity

RICOH Spaces enabled Ricoh NZ to create a modern, sustainable workspace that encourages collaboration and productivity. It facilitated the optimisation of their spaces, reducing required floor area from 3,000m² to 1,500m², while halving the number of desks. This resulted in a nearly 50% reduction in Ricoh NZ's expenses across the board, empowering them to reinvest in their people, technology, and additional fitouts.

A review of analytics after the first few weeks showed the sit-stand desks to be the first to be booked out and highly sought after. More sit-stand desks were added to accommodate the demand and occupancy remained high, validating the decision. Further adjustments are planned based on the data provided by RICOH Spaces.

The new office at 34 Sale Street is now truly a "Workplace of the Future", serving not just as Ricoh NZ's Auckland headquarters, but as a live demonstration to prospective customers of the possibilities available.


